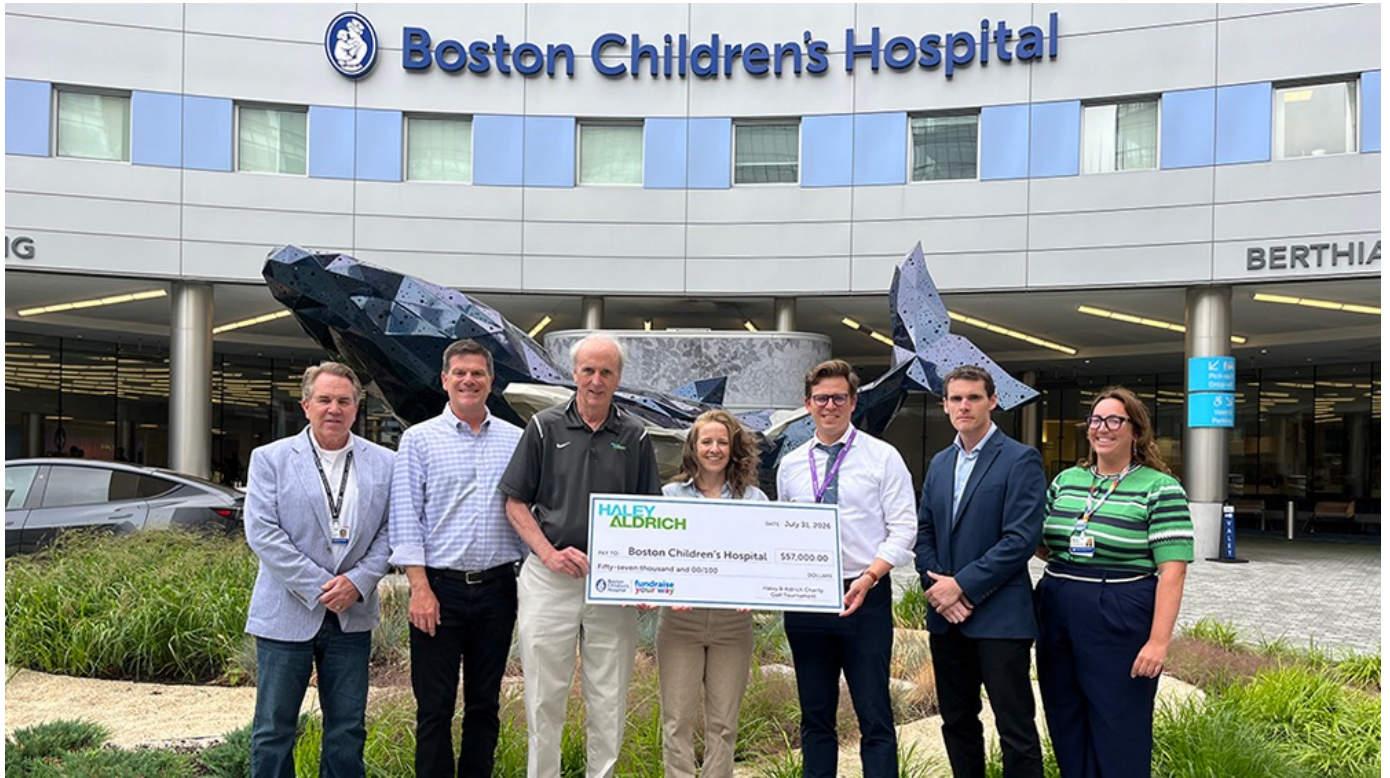

At the 16th annual golf tournament, Haley & Aldrich and sponsors raise \$57,000 for Boston Children's Hospital.
